

Miss Dior Chair

The Miss Dior Chair is part of a 'Room Of One's Own' writing pavilion by Slovenian designer Nika Zupanc. She used Virginia Woolf's essay as inspiration for the small, latticed pavilion complete with table, chair and lamp. Miss Dior motifs, such as the bow and the pale pink color, were incorporated into the chair's design. A scaled-

down version of the wooden lattice was used for the seat. Zupanc was one of fifteen designers asked by curator Herve Mikaeloff to contribute to a 2013 exhibition celebrating the Miss Dior perfume. The pavilion was on display in the Galerie Courbe at the Grand Palais in Paris.
